In December 1965, Bob Schulten, my mentor moved his business to a Texaco Station on Hurstbourne Lane and I bought him out at the station I worked for him at, at 4300 Shelbyville Road. This was really a lucky break for me. Even though I was only 22 years old, my friendship with Jack Wessling and Bob was the deciding factor, and the fact that the station American was to build for me, was not progressing as fast as it was supposed to. I believe I was the youngest American Oil Station owner with the third largest American station in the state of Kentucky. I paid Bob \$5,466.00 for all his items, and sold my other American Station to Bill Riebel, who was a real good man. I also bought Bob's old GMC truck for \$640.00. I stayed with American for about two years until Enco executives approached me to take over a new station being built at Hubbards Lane and Shelbyville Road. I had approached Enco way back when and they wouldn't even officially meet with me because of my age. Success sure changed their minds! I just could not pass up the opportunity to open a brand new station with what I thought was one of the top companies in the country, (Boy, did I learn differently).


