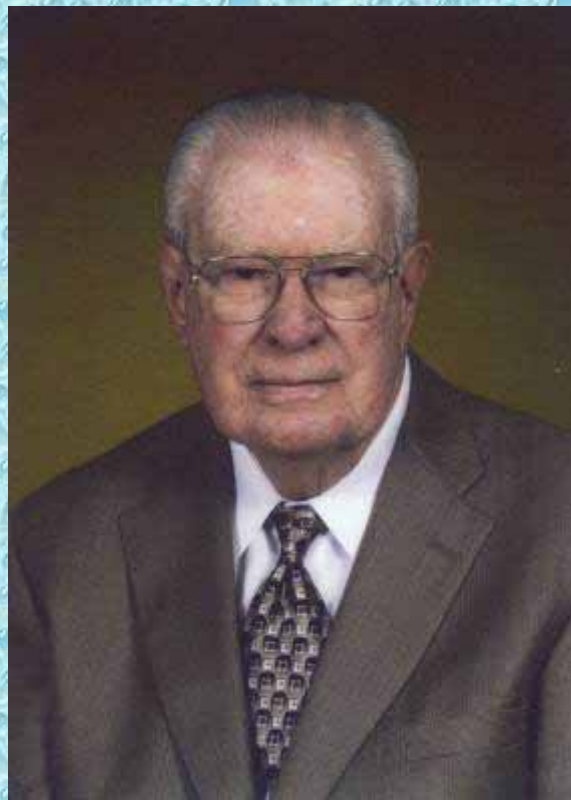

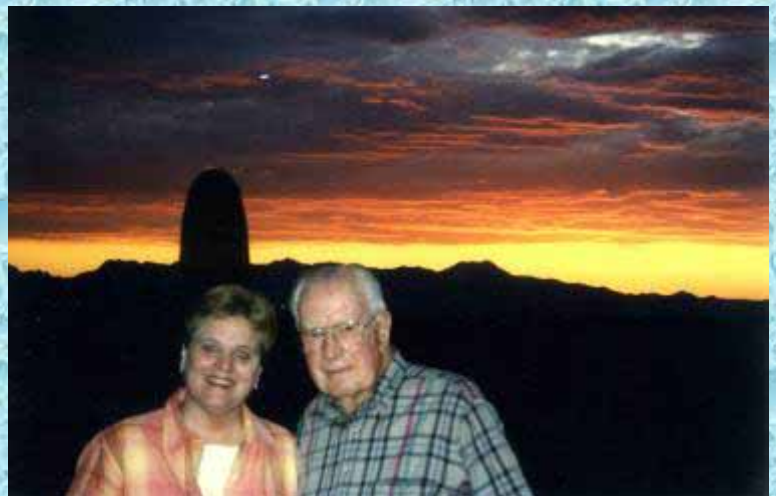

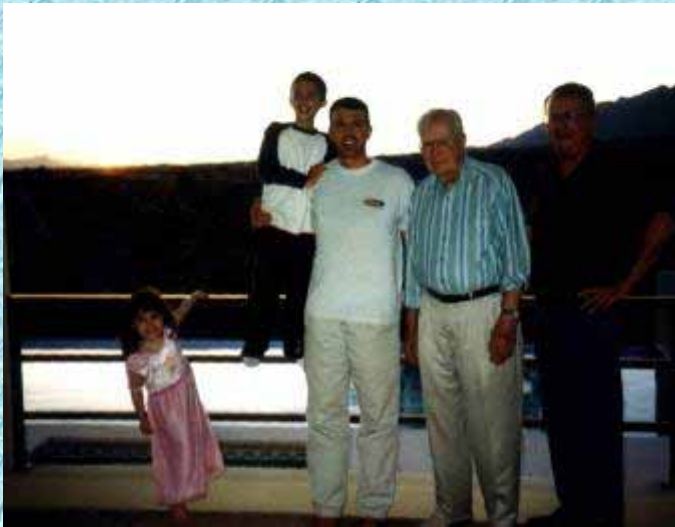

Clint was preceded in death by his wife Charlotte in 1997.

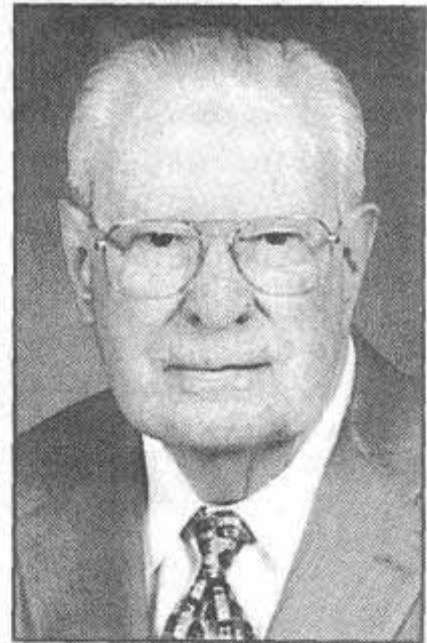
He is survived by his sister Elizabeth Spendlove (Gordon) of Denver, CO.

After Charlotte's death in 1997, Clint moved one mile north to Santa Catalina Villas Retirement Community where he spent eight years of high quality life among new friends.
