



Old Glory Mine - Mill Around 1900












Burros Carrying Wood to Power the Ore Crushers 1903










Old Glory Dam and Reservoir Around 1900





Old Glory Reservoir Around 1900












Ambrose and Grace Ring's "Shack" at Warsaw 1906




Inside the "Shack" - I 1906
























1901 Oldsmobile at Old Glory 1903






Grace Ring "Looking into Mexico" 1906






Ambrose Ring in Reflective Moment 1906


